

GATPO Action Plan

(Science, Faith, and Value Education for Peaceful Co-existence)

1. Objectives

1. To develop an integrated perspective combining science and faith.
2. To conduct philosophical and scientific analysis of Creationism and the moral attributes of the Creator.
3. To promote religion- and ethics-based education.
4. To disseminate open education and value education universally.
5. To contribute to peaceful coexistence and the development of a humane society.

Core Purpose

1. To clarify the path of integrated truth-seeking between science and religion.
2. To establish foundations for humanistic and peaceful coexistence.
3. To promote ethical values, knowledge, and a correct understanding of the Creator.

2. Major Activities

A. Creator & Creationism

Goal:

To analyze Creationism from scientific and philosophical perspectives and to explore the ethical values of the Creator.

Approach:

1. **Establishment of Research Institutions:**
Creation of research centers focused on Creationism and Divine Ethics.
2. **Research Projects:**
Comparative analysis of different philosophical and scientific theories.
3. **Seminars & Workshops:**
Multidimensional discussions involving scholars, scientists, and educators.
4. **Publications:**
Research reports, books, and academic journals.

B. Religion & Correct Philosophy

Goal:

To identify a welfare-oriented and correct religious philosophy through philosophical and scientific analysis of world religions.

Approach:

1. **Comparative Studies:**
Analysis of religion, morality, and humanistic perspectives.
2. **Visual Content Development:**
Educational graphic and animated visual materials.
3. **Workshops & Dialogue Forums:**
Participation of religious scholars, academics, and social activists.
4. **Interfaith Interface Peace Fair:**
A platform for interreligious harmony, understanding, and peace.
5. **Publications:**
Educational books, articles, and research papers.

C. Open & Value Education

Goal:

To make education omnipresent and to disseminate value-based education universally.

Approach:

1. **Educational Campaigns:**
 - Inspirational quotes and motivational stickers, banners, and billboards.
 - Installation at road intersections, educational institutions, and public spaces.
2. **Educational Sculptures:**
Symbolic sculptures representing peace, morality, and divine values.
3. **Open Learning Platforms:**
Public and online classes and workshops for learners.
4. **Visual Learning Platforms:**
Value education through interactive video content and AR/VR-based educational experiences.

1. **Research Institutions:**
Creationism & Ethics Research Center.

Educational sculptures and graphical exhibitions.
3. **Open Learning Centers & Online Platforms.**
